

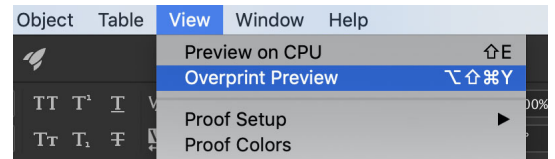


Checking for overprinting elements in Adobe InDesign

Checking for overprints is extremely simple in InDesign, and always a good idea to check before you create your PDF.

After opening your document, go to the “**View**” menu, then select “**Overprint Preview**”. You can turn the option on and off, just to see if there are any elements that are not going to print correctly.

If there are elements that do not appear in the Overprint Preview, then they will not print in the final print run.
